Mr. Donahue is Aries Engineering, Inc.'s (Aries') lead regulatory Compliance Engineer and project manager for environmental due diligence for commercial and industrial transactions. Mr. Donahue provides technical assistance to manufacturers regarding compliance with environmental regulations and laws, Brownfields Program, facility permitting and reimbursement from the New Hampshire Petroleum Cleanup Funds.

Mr. Donahue has provided consulting services for over 200 New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) remedial and industrial compliance-regulated sites.
